Merlot and Cabernet Franc dominate this blend, giving the classic 'Saint Emilion' style. Perfectly balanced, fruitful and warming with the age to provide a perfectly harmonious length of finish.

**Domaine de Cardon, Mercurey Premier Cru** £80.00  
Burgundy, France, 2015

100% wonderfully ripe Pinot Noir grown in the sun trap of the Burgundian 'Les Croichots'. Oaked for 10 months, this top cuvée is full, fleshy with a huge depth of flavour.

**Château Mongravey, Margaux** £85.00

## BEER

Reading's brewing heritage began with Simonds' Brewery in Broad Street in 1785. Simonds' Brewery merged with Courage in 1960 and moved to Bridge Street and then to the Berkshire Brewery in south Reading in 1978, until it closed in 2010. Perhaps The Corn Stores once housed the wheat needed to supply these breweries. Historically an important industry to the town, it's a product that is at the heart of Rarebreed.

In addition to the collection below, we also have a changing range of seasonal and local beers, lagers and ciders.
